Privacy Policy

Information We Collect & How We Use It

The Capitol doesn't make money from ads. So we don't collect data in order to advertise to you. The tracking we do at The Capitol is to make our product work as well as possible.

In order to give you the best possible experience using The Capitol, we collect information from your interactions with our network. Some of this information, you actively tell us (such as your email address, which we use to track your account or communicate with you). Other information, we collect based on actions you take while using The Capitol, such as what channels you interact with and the frequency and duration of your activities.

Sharing of Information

We will not rent or sell your information into third parties outside The Capitol and its group companies (including any parent, subsidiaries and affiliates) without your consent.

We may revise this Privacy Policy from time to time. The most current version of the policy will govern our processing of your personal data and will always be at our website.
