

# Privacy Policy

## 1. Introduction

We at Stasher Capital respect your privacy and are committed to protecting your personal data. This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, disclose, retain, and protect your information when you access or use our services, website, subscriptions, and community (collectively, the “Services”).

## 2. Data We Collect

We collect two types of data:

**2.1 Data You Provide:** When you register, subscribe, upload content, engage with our community or contact us, you may provide personal data such as your name, email address, billing information, username, contact details, and other registration information.

**2.2 Data We Automatically Collect:** When you use our Services we may collect technical and usage data such as IP addresses, browser/operating system details, device identifiers, pages visited, click-streams, referral sources, time stamps, and cookies.

## 3. How We Use Your Data

We use your personal data for the following purposes:

- To deliver, operate and maintain the Services and manage your account.
- To communicate with you, including emails, notifications, updates, and service-related messages.
- To send newsletters, promotional materials or marketing communications **only if you’ve consented** (you may opt-out at any time).
- To improve, analyze and tailor our Services, develop new features, generate analytics, and plan for business growth.
- To comply with legal and regulatory obligations, enforce our terms, protect our rights and respond to lawful requests.

## 4. Data Sharing and Disclosure

Your data may be shared in the following circumstances:

- With **service providers** who assist us in delivering the Services (e.g., hosting, payment processors, email platform). These providers are bound to use your data only for agreed purposes and protect it.
- With **third parties** when required to create or manage your account, deliver services you've requested, or comply with legal obligations.
- We **do not sell** your personal data to any third parties for their own marketing use.

## 5. Cookies and Tracking Technologies

We use cookies and similar technologies to recognise your device, maintain your session, provide you with a more efficient experience, track user behaviour, and gather analytics. You can typically set your browser to refuse cookies, but this may affect your use of certain features of our Services.

## 6. International Transfers

If you or we are located in jurisdictions outside your home country, your data may be transferred to and stored in other countries. By using the Services, you consent to the transfer of your information to countries which may not have the same data protection laws as your country of residence.

## 7. Data Retention

We retain your personal data only as long as necessary to fulfil the purposes described in this policy (e.g., providing the Services, complying with legal obligations, resolving disputes). After that period your data will either be permanently deleted or anonymised.

## 8. Your Rights

Depending on your local law, you may have the following rights regarding your personal data:

- Access your personal data, request a copy.
  - Correct or update inaccurate or incomplete data.
  - Delete or erase your personal data ("right to be forgotten").
  - Restrict or object to our processing of your data.
  - Request portability of your data (i.e., receive it in a machine-readable format).
